GTB, the Specialized Mediation Team, **helps people with disabilities or health problems who need extra help** in finding and retaining suitable work. They also help companies hire and reintegrate suitable employees.

GTB works closely with VDAB. Their employees collaborate with VDAB colleagues in local work stores ('werkwinkels'). You can contact GTB directly for information about returning to work. To start a subsidized guidance program at GTB, you must first visit the VDAB.

During the guidance program, the first step is to look for paid work in the regular labor market. If this is not successful, there are other options such as social economy, employment care, or voluntary work. GTB not only helps you find a job, but also helps you make your own choices and take action to get a job.

Attention points
GTB is available to people without an employment contract and to people with an employment contract who are inactive due to illness (with a health insurance benefit)
